



Download the AngleMe app from your iOs or Android device store.

Upon opening the app, you should see the following loading screen.



The landing screen will be blank at first, but over time will show your previous video captures and their outcomes.


As you record assessments they will appear in the list as shown in the example.



We have also added an improved search and filter function.

If a trainer or observer has previously taken an angle assessment, this can be found and reviewed prior to conducting a new assessment.

Hit the + button at the bottom to begin



You will be prompted to choose your camera or you can upload an existing image or Video.

You will notice we also have a quick link to this user guide available.

To take a new video select 'Use Camera'.



Instructions

TIPS TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF YOUR IMAGES/VIDEOS

Ensure your flash is off unless it is too dark to see the image





Tap on the screen to auto focus the camera

Use the volume button on the side of the phone to take the picture. Tapping the screen will shake the device.





Step 4

Next up, choose if you want to take a picture or a video. We find video is best for analysis.


Once you click your choice, confirm by choosing 'Use Camera'.



The screen will display your camera feed.
Press the record button to take your video.


Once you are finished press stop on the same button.

Select 'Use Video' to move on.



Next, set your 'desired angle'.


Here the user can choose which angle that the person steeling or sharpening wants to have and then the observer or trainer using the app can take the video and show them the actual angle they are steeling or sharpening at.




Ready to go? Press play (1) to watch you video, and again to Pause it.

When ready add an angle by selecting either of the angle options shown below (2) and (3)

Move the white dots on the vertices to show your angle.




When using the Angle insertion feature, it is best to use the slider function to slide the video back or forward to the exact spot you want to then use the angle.




If you use the Pause button instead of sliding the video, you may notice on occasion the video will 'jump' a frame.

This is done on purpose to attach the angle to a specific frame. This ensures that when you want to navigate back and forth you land on the frame you originally set the angle on.




You can continue adding more angles over the video. Each of these will be recorded and displayed at the top of the screen.

You can jump between any of these angles by tapping on them.



You will also notice that once you have set the desired angle and you overlay an angle onto the video when creating an assessment, the angle color will change based on how far you are from the desired angle.

+ or - 2 degrees and it goes orange, greater than 4 degrees and it goes red.



Now we are ready to save the assessment result.

You will be able to see the colour of the angle result (red, orange or green) under result.

Simply enter the details of the person into the fields and press SAVE.
